Dear Sr. Rojas-Marcos:

The Smithsonian Institution has established a Center for Short-Lived Phenomena to obtain and disseminate information on short-lived natural events including volcanic eruptions, major earthquakes, the birth of new islands, the fall of meteorites and large fireballs, and sudden changes in biological and ecological systems. The Smithsonian Institution aims to improve opportunities for research by providing an organization whose function it is to collect and disseminate information on short-lived geophysical and biological events.

We have been asked by Dr. Barbara Middlehurst to coordinate communications activities for possible observed short-lived lunar phenomena during the Apollo 8 Manned Lunar Orbit Mission. This mission begins at 1250 hours GMT on 21 December and is planned to terminate at 16 hours, 9 minutes GMT December 28. The astronauts will be in lunar orbit for approximately 20 hours beginning at 0950 GMT on 24 December and ending at 0550 hours GMT on 28 December. The total duration of the mission is planned to be 7 days, 3 hours and 19 minutes.

During the duration of this mission, the Center for Short-Lived Phenomena will be pleased to receive cabled reports of any observed transient lunar events. (See enclosure for communications procedures.) These reports will be communicated to the National Aeronautics and Space Administration, Manned Space Flight Center, at Houston, Texas, where they will be evaluated for possible transmission to the astronauts in cislunar space or orbiting the moon. If opportunity permits, the astronauts may attempt to confirm ground base observations of transient lunar phenomena by visual observations and/or photography.

Conversely, transient events observed by the astronauts during the Apollo 8 Mission will be communicated to NASA and relayed to this Center for cabled transmission to selected astronomers and astronomical observers around the world.

We thank you for your cooperation and look forward to your participation during the Apollo Mission.

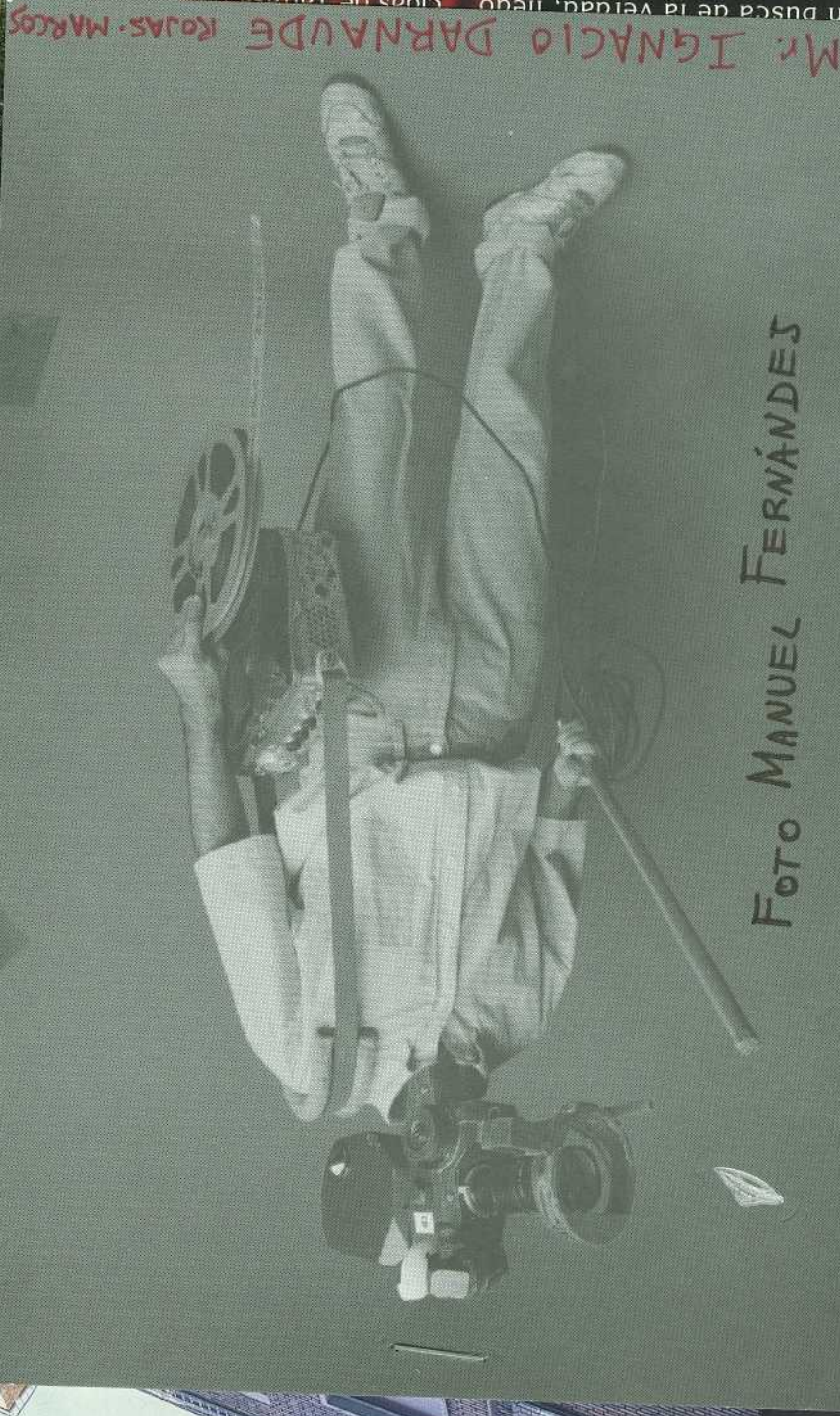

La conexión Tarrasa

José Félix Rodríguez Montero nació en Aguadulce (Sevilla) el 21 de febrero de 1925. A principios de 1946 se trasladó a Tarrasa (Barcelona) para trabajar como pesador en una empresa textil. Su vida transcurría monótona hasta que, a principios de los años sesenta, se topó de bruces con el fascinante, y por aquel entonces incipiente, enigma ovni. Quizá fuese exagerada la descripción que de él hizo el *Noticiero Universal* en su edición del 22 de junio de 1972 al afirmar: "Era una especie de Don Quijote del espacio que en lugar de libros de caballería



as leía textos de astronautas y extraterrestres, hasta llegar a una aventura en la que su molino fue un tren". Lo cierto es que alguna anomalía inexplicable debió ocurrir en la mente de este obrero para convencer al joven Juan Turú de que viajara hasta el planeta Júpiter. Turú, de 22 años de edad y natural de Tarrasa, un activo investigador perteneciente a grupos como el CEI (Centro de Estudios Interplanetarios), había conocido a José Félix hacía apenas un mes mediante un anuncio publicado en mayo de 1972 en la revista *Algo*. Ambos aparecieron decapitados en el kilómetro 335,950 de la vía férrea que une Mas Cornet y Torre Alavedra, a pocos metros del destaralado apeadero de Torrebonica.

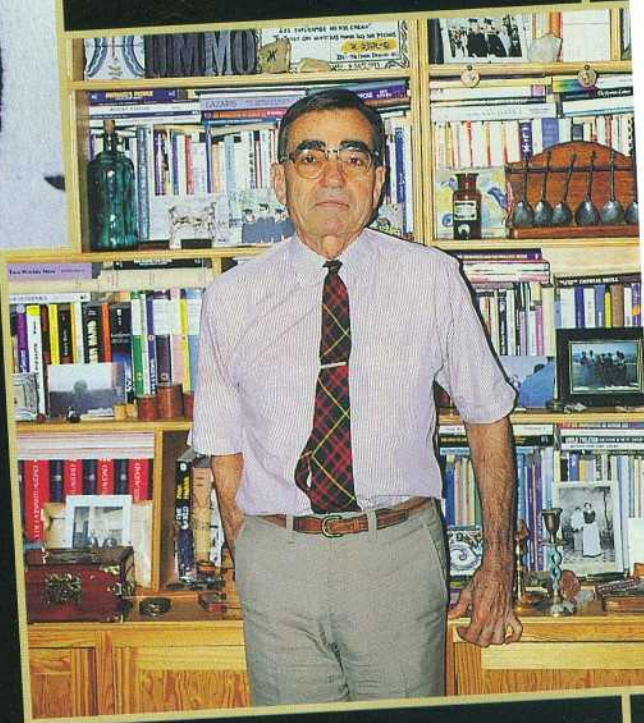

El investigador Ignacio Darnaude pensó que los sucesos de Tarrasa podían esconder una trama oculta cuyo objetivo sería acabar con el movimiento ufológico español.



Los dos cuerpos fueron encontrados a las 5:30 horas del martes 20 de junio de 1972, con la cabeza seccionada por las ruedas del tren. Habían decidido dejar este mundo y viajar por el éter hasta un lugar anhelado y lejano, dejando para ello su cuerpo físico en este valle de lágrimas. Como tarjeta de despedida aparecía una hoja con el mensaje "los extraterrestres nos llaman" que alguien, quizá un grupo de seguidores presentes en la dantesca escena, colocó sobre uno los cuerpos.

El mazazo que provocó la dramática noticia estuvo a punto de hacer desaparecer la ufología hispana. Un divulgador como Marius Lliguet, que recibió una carta póstuma de los suicidas, intentó acabar con su vida víctima de la tensión mental, siendo recluido en un psiquiátrico. Mientras tanto, los principales estudiosos del país se carteaban preguntándose si merecía la pena seguir adelante en la divulgación de los enigmas del espacio ante sucesos tan tristes como el de Tarrasa.

"CLEAR INTENT" IN WESTERN EUROPE

ON a number of occasions over recent months we have referred to the thunderous silence with which the book "Clear Intent", by Laurence Fawcett and Barry Greenwood, has apparently been received in all the countries of Western Europe, and we have asked FSR readers in all those countries to let us know of any mention of the book anywhere in any of the media and in any of the languages of the Continent.

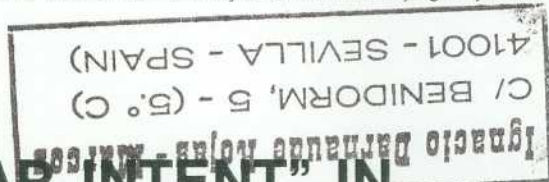
We have now heard of two such references, seemingly very brief, in UFO study bulletins in Sweden. (We have received no text.)

We have reported at length on the tremendous success of the massive drive against UFO research or discussion in France, and today, *more than two years after its publication*, we still have no word from anybody regarding any mention whatsoever of "Clear Intent" in that country — not even — to our very great astonishment — in our respected contemporary journal *Lumières Dans La Nuit*!

(And here we might mention, in parentheses, that one of our French correspondents reports that not only are there no new books on Ufology in that country, but that it is becoming increasingly difficult even to find any old or second-hand books on the subject there. What is taking place in France is no doubt what we have already seen here in Britain in connection with any books about the nasty doings of the USSR and its agents throughout the world. Anyone familiar with the bookshops of the famous Charing Cross Road in London may have noted the great scarcity of such books there. We understand that the Soviets and their allies have agents going around everywhere and scooping up such "embarrassing" items from the market.)

We also understand that there has been no reference yet in Belgium to "Clear Intent" though this perhaps should surprise nobody.

Likewise we know of no reference yet anywhere in Spain, either in the

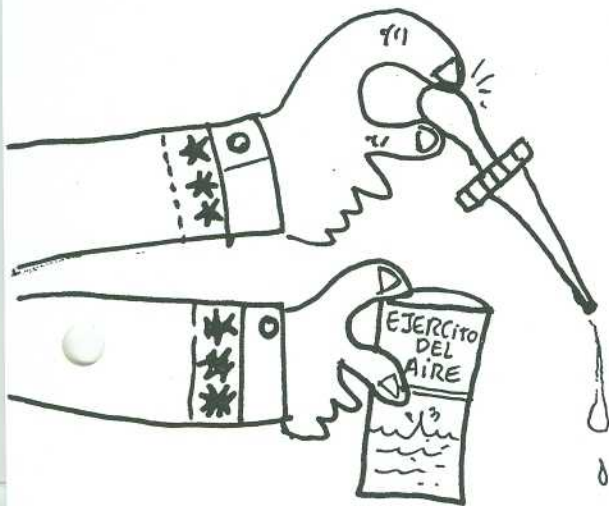

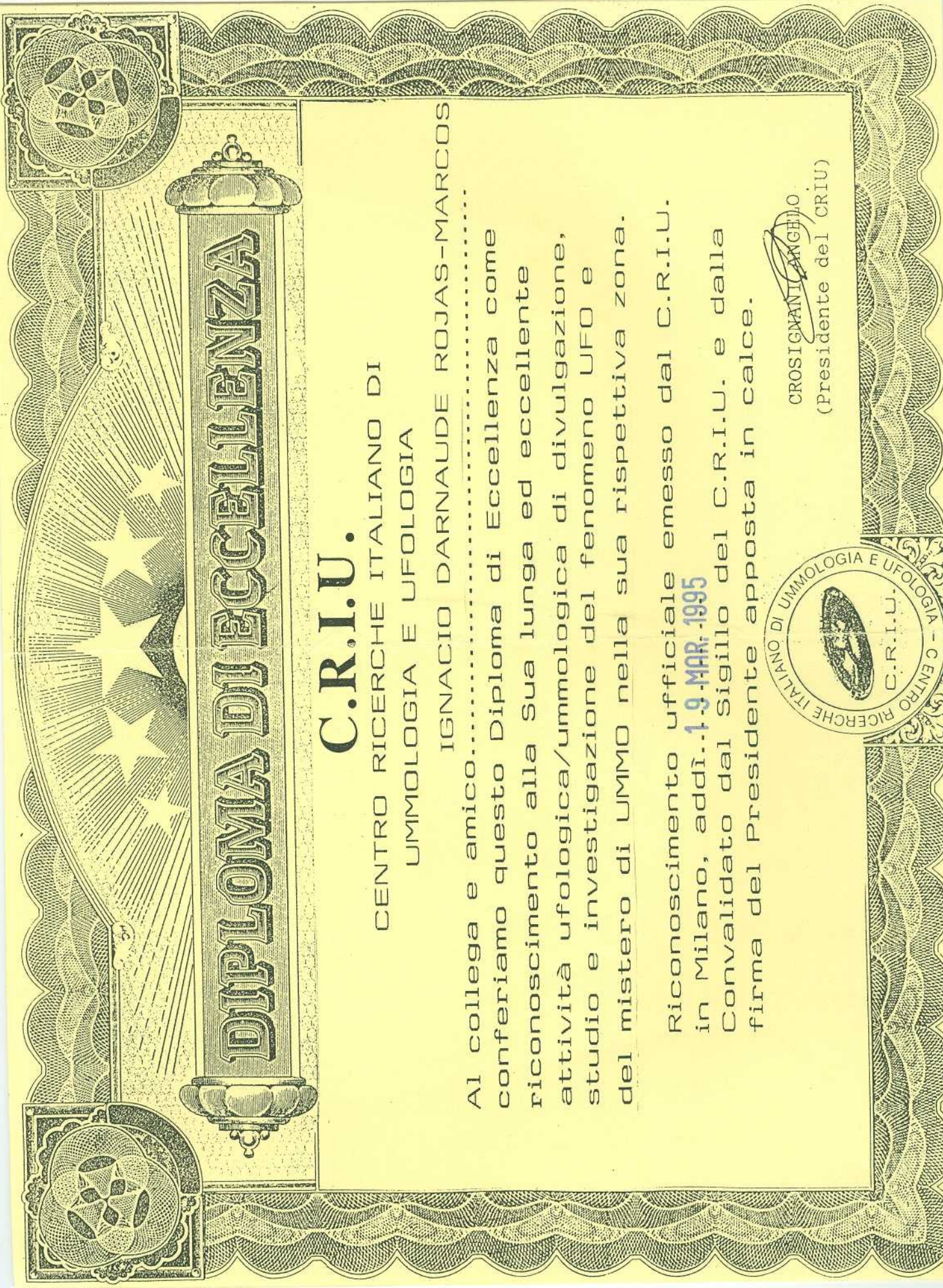
