are normally strongly physical mediums, since practically all phical mediumism originates from Darkness. The spirits of the Li obviously never use such mediums as intermediaries between the selves and human beings.

Physical phenomena that are produced with the help of Darki include levitations of the medium or of the séance participants; regular flickering light phenomena, such as larger or smaller phonescent spots, misty formations and the like; all genuine mat alizations and dematerializations during séances, violent explos blows or noises and all irregular tappings and so on.

All regular tappings, with equal intervals between each knock, can be perfor only by the spirits of the Light and therefore belong under the laws of the Li These tappings can in the presence of very strong Light radiations ring with a and sonorous metallic sound, even though there are no metallic objects in the rewhere they occur. The spirits of the Light have often called upon their earthly here in this manner.

Materializations during séances are performed only by the ear bound spirits, including the Eldest. None of the Youngest has appeared in a materialized state at any séance; their appearant occur spontaneously and usually without the intervention of nedium, since they render themselves visible by the power of twill, that is to say, they let the Light-atoms of which their spondies consist oscillate with a reduced frequency – or they appeared any oyant people.

It has happened at materializations that completely honour mediums in their earthly ignorance, and in the belief that they wacting correctly, have let themselves be used as intermediaried unscrupulous spirits. These mediums have usually believed that twere doing a good deed in lending their assistance to such phenena, partly so as to provide proof of life after death, and partly the good intention of acting as intermediary between the living the "dead". But since God has never permitted the earthbound its to make themselves known in this way, the spirits who have exploited and abused such mediums must carry the full responsity for their forbidden actions. On the other hand, if the medium been warned by the guardian spirit and has thus acted in defiance conscience, the medium must bear the full responsibility for which has taken place.

Many strongly physical mediums, the Eldest, can by the will their spirit – and with no help whatsover from disincarnated spirit produce levitation phenomena, such as the lifting of objects from id base or causing smaller objects to float about in the air. This sally happens without the medium's human brain being aware of the spirit cannot influence its earthly body during trance the same strength as is normally the case.

Only a very small proportion of the materializations and other vsical phenomena known from séances are or have been genuine. Ost often it has been sleight-of-hand and thus pure deception on part of the human medium, a fact for which all who meddle with manifestations of Darkness must be prepared.

Certain kinds of trance phenomena will be described in the following. Under deep nce - a deep, insensible sleep - the medium's spirit was thrust aside from the hubody while some earthbound spirit availed itself of the body's organs of ch. Many genuine results have been produced in this manner, and several truthmessages have been given by deceased persons to relatives and friends. These sages were nearly always confined to purely earthly matters, especially the recall bast events and experiences so as to make known the identity of the deceased. A mber of earthbound spirits who were unknown to the séance participants have en exact proof of life after death by stating their name, occupation, place of th. native land, year of birth and death and so on, these particulars having been own by subsequent investigation to be completely accurate in many cases. The thbound spirits could normally say nothing about life in the spheres, since the mory of this does not as a rule awaken until the spirit has returned to its dwelling the transcendental world. However, a few have passed a number of obscure and ffused messages describing this life as well as they could remember it; but the fority always tried to evade direct questions on life after death, as they were samed to say anything too definite about the sufferings of their dismal existence the astral plane of the Earth. Only very few have given accounts fully describing earthbound existence in Darkness, without peace and without rest.

The many different messages from earthbound spirits, who unaccompanied by spirits of the Light had forcibly gained access to mediumistic communication, as occurred without God's permission, and therefore belong to the numerous nifestations of the intervention of Darkness.

Under deep trance the medium's own spirit frequently acts as communicator, hout the medium being aware of this, a circumstance that can easily be verified an acute observer, since such messages are usually coloured by the medium's own criences and opinions. This is also a form of the influence of Darkness, for centhe medium cannot always be blamed, since in most cases it is due to accumuons of Darkness that are introduced by one or more of the participants in the seances. Seances should therefore never be made available to larger circles or the public, since such "performances" only attract Darkness and adversely affect

This also applies to photographs of spirits, of which only a few are genuine.

and demanding deity, who grants nothing without suitable tribute the form of blood sacrifice or sweet-scented offerings – a divin with whom mankind must constantly barter to attain the desir blessings. But also the many who now live in slavish fear of th God and Father will sometime in the future, through the many p gressive incarnations, be able to feel the child's unswerving faith a trust in Him.

Many people carry in their thoughts and in their hearts a glori and clear reflection of the Divinity, but man-made dogmas, han down from generation to generation, have veiled and obscured original image that they carried with them from their existence in transcendental world. These people should search their innern selves, should reject all false assertions and wrong conclusions, the veil is lifted from the divine reflection, that it may again st clearly in all its radiant beauty.

But with the passing of time and as century is added to cent and Darkness is slowly eliminated, more and more human be will begin to understand God's boundless love, His justice, His k ness and compassion, and they will realize that they have belit God by endowing Him, the Highest One, with mere human quities, which must be removed before His image can once more st exalted, pure and noble.

Every human being should strive to understand this idealization the Divinity.

When Christ in his Speech to humanity (see p. 109) says: words shall sound unto all the peoples of the Earth. All shall them, and they shall reach unto the farthest regions of the Ear he does not mean that those who are now able to understand an rejoice in his Gospel of Love should forthwith go out into the w and proclaim his words to others holding different ideas and liefs. Rather, he said this because he knew that sooner or late people, some in their present and others in their future incarnat will be able to achieve acceptance of his message with heartfel and with deep understanding.

But even though that time still lies far in the future, when all ing religions will have merged into one common religion, hu beings themselves can do much to shorten this time by not stragainst their inner convictions, by not assuming a posture of if ference and hostility to this message that is presented to them the transcendental world. They should strive to make it known to propagate it from individual to individual, from people to pe in a calm and dignified manner, without compelling propagan fanatic missionary zeal; for this message can be of great help to

man spirit so that in its earthly existence it can become the mirror at captures and radiates a purer, stronger and more beautiful age of the Divinity than has been the case in the past. But it must clear to all that the human reflection of God and the divine, no atter how glorious it may become in the earthly existence of human ings, can never fully reach its exalted ideal.

God's children who sprang from His Fatherly bosom - the Eldest, Youngest and the human spirits - have all received the gift of thal life; but since God never compels anyone to receive His gifts, has also endowed every created spirit with a free will, with the at of self-determination; but He has thereby limited His own Will His own Knowledge. On reaching a certain level of maturity all a's children can by the right of self-determination themselves dewhether they wish to receive the gift of eternal life or whether they choose to sink back into God's Fatherly bosom.

this truth has been applied in an erroneous manner in Buddhist doctrine, in the according to some interpretations the human spirit, upon attaining the test perfection, sinks back into "Nirvana" – into the Divinity. Buddha himself inally taught that when the human spirit through numerous rebirths had attainterfect freedom from all earthly influence and all earthly desire, it then returned a source – to the Divinity – from which it sprang. This absorption, or reversion, not considered by Buddha as the annihilation of the individuality but as an inhuble bond with the divine, whereby the reverted self could follow the earthly in serenity and contemplation. This absorption into the Divinity could somethe recognized in fleeting moments by certain highly advanced spirits in their in existence, and was then an indication that the spirit was living through its incarnation.

il creation, the primary (the transcendental) as well as the secary (the star universes) and all that has been called forth from thess through the fall of the Eldest, can at any time God chooses assolved once more by the power of His omnipotent Will into the lents from which it was created or evolved.

In theory God can thus let Himself and all creation sink back "Logos"; in practice He will never do so, since through His uning love for all His many children He has bound Himself for eternity by giving them the promise of eternal life.

At the moment God emanated Himself, He drew Darkness un the Light in a mighty circulation through His flaming Being, Darkness should thus be absorbed and purified by the Light

When God resolved to create the star universes, Darkness was from absorbed and eliminated, it existed with latent poles as a w

undercurrent in the swirling waves of the Light.

Since even the highest oscillations of the Darkness that enclosed by the Light are much slower than the lowest frequencie the Light, Darkness will always precipitate, so to speak, in the se the Light, for which reason God had to form the innermost conthe four mother suns from the less rapid oscillations of the Lig imperceptible to the human eye – which once more enclosed Darkness, with its still lower frequency of oscillation. From innermost cores of the globes to their outermost limits the oscillations increase in speed. As its frequency increases the Light increases in concentration of strength and in ethereal radiance, which reason the outer layer becomes like a radiant corona – not ceptible to the human eye – though without attaining the degree concentration and ethereal radiance emitted by those oscillation the Light that, through the power of God's Will, created His Kingdom (the Central Globe).

Since all of the globes in the star universes have directly or i rectly originated from the four first-created mother suns, they ar identical in their structure. But since the ether (the Light, and Darkness precipitated in it) flows through and pervades all sp and thereby all the globes in the universes, the darker cores of globes will gradually diminish as the waves of the Light in their culation draw more and more Darkness away to be purified through the collaboration of the collaborat

God's flaming Being.

When God had chosen the Earth as the dwelling place for beings He had thought to create, He formed from the high ethereal – oscillations of the Light a world of perfect beauty that inded the Earth as a sphere, as a spherical shell. It was God's intion that those of His first-created children who were chosen to the leaders of the inhabitants of the Earth should stay here while rying out their task. The ethereal radiations from this transcential world should according to God's plan and together with the ereal-astral radiations of the corona of Light of the Earth's sun we regulated climatic conditions on the Earth itself.

But when the Eldest began to experiment with their attempts at ation, large quantities of Darkness were separated from the ether, H these rayaged the world of Light that God had created around Forth 1 This separation activated the Poles of Darkness, and as a tion of the separated Darkness slowly approached the Earth, the herto latent poles in the Globe's core of Darkness were gradually ivated under the influence of the approaching, polarized rkness. As the Darkness drew closer to the core, it intermingled are and more with the Globe's ethereal corona of Light, causing a inificant reduction in the corona's frequency of oscillation. When rkness reached the core of the Earth, the entire Globe was darkand it appeared to be without any luminous corona (this corowas visible only from the transcendental world). But because the tht. through God's victory over Darkness, can never be extin-Bhed or conquered. Darkness could not eliminate or destroy the Doe's ethereal radiation of Light, but could only contaminate and scure it.

Although the frequency of oscillation of the corona of Light was uced and moderated by the influx of Darkness, the radiation of the was still strong enough to contain or fixate the Darkness that ed with the Globe's core of Darkness. Due to this fixation, the principle of the polarized Darkness fused with the seeds of life — en by God — that were in the Globe's corona of Light, and cells of ious kinds emerged. Some of these cells were of dual sex, others re of single sex. The reproduction, or generation, of new dual is took place, and still takes place, by the simple processes of ision, ligation, and the like; while on the other hand the generan of new single cells took place, and still takes place, by a precedunion of two cells of opposite sex.

Some microbes can reproduce in two ways. For example, when certain diseaseducing bacteria enter the body as parasites, they reproduce by a simple division gradually reduces their vitality, and the illness is cured as the bacteria expire, or

Most of the globes in the galactic system to which the Earth belongs are contaminated by ness to a greater or lesser extent; many are completely saturated

as their vitality is reduced to the point where they no longer interfere with the bod normal functions. But if the patient receives a new infection of the same kind bet all bacteria have expired, a union of the present and former bacteria occurs, we the resulting divisions. If the new bacteria are sufficiently vital, the former ones revitalized, whereby the illness flares up again, until the vitality of the bacteria weakened once more through numerous divisions. The disease can of course be a viated or cured in other ways, for example by the body's own antitoxin, by admistering antidotes, and so forth. The foregoing refers only to the normal life-cycle the bacteria.

Bacteria of related strains can also merge, or be absorbed by one another, subsequent division as a result. In this way new strains appear that produce diseases.

Each single seed of life that God by the power of His Thought a Will had implanted in the Earth's ethereal corona of Light carr within itself the prototype of the animal or the plant, i.e., the fo into which these seeds – by the power of God's Will and at a t determined by Him – should grow forth in the world of Light the wished to create on Earth. Since these seeds were brought for to earthly life through a union with the life-principle of Darkn they became subject to the distorting, malforming and degeneral influence of Darkness. But since the corona of Light had fixated Darkness that transformed the Globe, the Light retained a reguling, elevating, differentiating and harmonizing influence on single and dual-sexed cells and their reproduction, which had b produced by the fusion of the seeds of life with the life principle Darkness.

The dual-sexed cells represented the lowest reproductive life for of Darkness, which could not lead to higher or more complex for and which for this reason were unable to produce even the weal reflection of the prototypes that rested in the seeds of life given God. The union of the single-sexed cells (male and female), cont led and guided by the regulating and harmonizing influence of corona of Light, is therefore a blind, mechanical simulation Darkness of the consciously-willed union of primal Thought primal Will that resulted in the emergence of God as a persence.

Under the influence of the corona of Light through million years, with the continuous cell division and cell formation result

from the merging of male and female cells, the more and more mmplex forms of life evolved, the various intricate tissues organized hto bones, muscles, nerves, and the like, and into the various modes f digestion, reproduction, etc., both in the animal and in the plant forlds. All these forms continually strive toward the prototypes uplanted by God in the original seeds of life. This striving was, and still is, unceasingly restrained and disturbed by the degenerative ndencies of Darkness, and during this time when the power of arkness over the Earth was so exceptionally much greater than the nwer of the Light the formation of cells led to the most hideous nd bizarre forms, for example through the animals' mating at ranom, so that in many ways they were departing from rather than tvancing toward the prototypes that were embedded in the seeds. the Light gains greater power over the "separated Darkness". ese mutations of Darkness will disappear, which means that the any hideous and harmful animal species will slowly die out over e coming thousands or millions of years. (The same holds true for e plant kingdom).

When human intelligence began experimenting with creating new forms within existing animal and plant species, human beings in many ways forestalled the luence of the Light. If these hybrids are to achieve a natural, independent and tinued propagation within the developed forms, they must for hundreds, usands or perhaps millions of years be exposed to the same care and the same thment to which they are now subjected. Otherwise, when they are once again left hemselves, they will sooner or later revert to those forms they had reached under slow but progressive ordering, elimination, adaptation and harmonization cess of the corona of Light.

However, the earthly forms will never reach the perfection of the prototypes in primary seeds given by God, partly because these, for example in the animal dom, had been destined to lead a life without propagation and without death, partly because Darkness cannot be completely eliminated until the Earth itself is royed and has been dissolved.

When the Eldest created the human beings, it was their intention the species they created should be maintained through reprotion. They endowed for this reason the male and female lifets of the human sexual cells with a characteristic, with a form,

As a result of the overwhelming influence of Darkness at that time, many of the primary types given by God were completely destroyed, for which reason the creatures that from the damaged seeds did not bear the faintest resemblance to the original types.

that corresponded to the human type represented by the given seed These primary seed prototypes (invisible under any form of hum observation) were thus to be the principal foundation for the cr tures of the Eldest and, through reproduction, were destined to reborn and maintained in the future generations so long as the Ea was in the power of the Eldest. But when God adopted the hum T. A race and endowed the physical body with a divine element, the bo was brought under the harmonizing influence of the Light. And an ever-increasing number of the Youngest were incarnated amd human beings, the fulness of beauty that they all carried in the thought also began through procreation to exert a strong influed on the Eldest's primary prototypes in the human life-seeds. This fluence was mostly directed toward the beautification and ennot ment of the physical body. During the many millions of years t the human body has been subject to the progressive and beautify influence of the Youngest and of the Light, the primary prototy of the Eldest have gradually departed somewhat from the origin degrading stamp of Darkness. This ennoblement is especially not able in those races where the Youngest are regularly incarnated.

The human male and female life-seeds will also at any given ti accurately reflect the personal characteristics of each individu Thus, all outer and inner family traits and talents inherited by individual from his or her ancestors, and all experience person acquired in life on Earth, lie dormant both in the physical and as life-seeds of the individual and can be transmitted to the offspr through procreation. Through the coincidence of various inter and external circumstances, these latent characteristics and tale can be caused to reappear in the new individuals. However, outw. characteristics as well as inner qualities can also, through vari coinciding causes, be repressed through several generations, of later to reappear in new combinations in a few or in several mem of the family.

Through the incarnations of the Youngest the primary hus prototype is drawn further and further away from its original pearance, both the astral and the physical. But if the Youngest to discontinue their incarnations, the ennobling stamp that they left on the human body would soon fade away and the physical b would begin to resemble its original prototype. All the psy enrichment that human beings have gained from the Youn through the astral counterpart would likewise slowly fade away most to the point of vanishing. And if God in addition were to

ack the divine element, human beings would within an appallingly hort time - a few thousand years - revert to the characteristics with hich they were endowed by the Eldest, characteristics that would far below and far more animal-like than those of the most primive peoples of today, and the last trace of spiritual life that humanihas received through the incarnations of the Youngest would at he same time completely disappear. Human beings would again be tirely the creatures of the Eldest.

Therefore: in the animal and plant kingdom a slow approach to he primary prototypes is taking place under the upgrading and rdering influence of the Light, an approach to those prototypes hat God at the creation of the Earth gave for the animal and plant he that He intended to call forth. However, in the human world a ow departure from the primary prototype is taking place under the rdering and beautifying influence of the Light and the Youngest, a enarture from the primary prototypes that were given by the Eldest the creation of mankind.

During the development of new individuals and through a combination of contrent circumstances under the influence of Darkness, both astral and physical versions toward the original prototypes can occur. The incursions of Darkness can ewise be so powerful as to cause deviations from these prototypes, thereby producmalformed offspring. If the incursions of Darkness go so deep as to impair the sis of the prototype, both astral and physical deviations, malformations and defincies can be inherited by the offspring. But should the human body for some ason become deformed or deficient during life on Earth, for example through amtations, surgical removal of organs, deformities caused by burns and the like, en the prototype is not changed. Only when <u>Darkness</u> intervenes directly and insmutes the prototype does the changed characteristic become heritable.

Because of the fixation by the corona of Light of the astral and olecular Darkness, all earthly life, all organic and inorganic subances arose as dualities, so that the forms that were due only to the olecular oscillations of the fixated material Darkness - oscillations larger particles - assumed an apparently solid consistency in the rthly world, but appeared misty and unreal when seen from the inscendental world: whereas the counterparts that were formed Om the fixated astral Darkness - faster oscillations of smaller par-Eles - in combination with the reduced and muted oscillations of polluted corona of Light assumed solid, visible forms and sures1 when seen from the transcendental world, but remained in-

visible to the eyes of human beings when they subsequently entere the earthly world.

Thus: the Earth's ethereal corona of Light fixated the Darkne that had fused with the core of the Earth: the faster and the le rapid oscillations of Darkness were thereby linked together. that the molecular products of Darkness were strengthened through the somewhat faster oscillations, smaller particles and great cohesive and adhesive properties of the astral Darkness. But the possibility was thereby created for the Light gradually to acqui a more regulating and balancing influence on the molecular pro ucts of Darkness on Earth, since the capacity of the molecul for stabilizing one another in the rotating oscillation, as well their capacity for mutual adhesion - as for example, in the stru turing of cells - was significantly strengthened through the fix tion and reinforcement of the stabilizing, cohesive and adhesi properties of the particles of astral Darkness by the corona Light. Where a pathological state - infection by micro-organism or other abnormal conditions - might threaten to dissolve t bond between the molecular products of Darkness and their a tral counterparts, the possibility was also created for the Light through its strong vital force and stabilizing, cohesive and hesive power, to counteract or arrest the incipient dissolution And in cases where the cause of this incipient dissolution cou be removed or eliminated, the greater stabilizing, cohesive and a hesive capacity of the Light would be able once more to bind t loosened bond between the molecular products of Darkness at their astral counterparts, whereby the complete separation that wou otherwise result in death and disintegration would be prevented. that, for example, the life span of earthly forms of animals a plants could be prolonged through the re-establishment by the Lig of the bond with their astral counterparts.

Through fixation by the corona of Light of the Darkness the flowed into and over the Earth, and of the life-principle that exist in it, the life-potential of the molecular products of Darkness withus improved and prolonged.

amid the destruction: by the power of His Will to dissolve and annihilate the Earth, the ravaged Kingdom and His eldest, fallen children; for on account of the re-absorption by the ether of the thereal radiations of the Earth and the ravaged Kingdom, the territory thus conquered by Darkness would have been completely pre-cluded from all further connection with the Light. But since God had endowed all His children with a free will, and thereby amited His own power over them, He could never annihilate the Eldest, no matter how deep they had fallen, without breaking His promise. For which reason this means of restituting the fallen and the destruction hat had occurred could never be realized, for if God had annihilated the existence of the Eldest, He would have done this against their with and against their with

In His omniscience God had foreseen this, and for this reason He ad laid a world of Light around the Earth - the Kingdom ravaged by Darkness - formed from the rapid, ethereal oscillations of the Light, and endowed the ethereal-astral corona of the Globe with a trength of Light far greater than that possessed by the other suns and ne stars and planets. The Earth's corona of Light thereby became so oncentrated that it was transformed from the ethereal-astral into he ethereal, and thus became capable of fixating the in-flowing Darkness. Should any of God's children succumb to Darkness, the ossibility was thus created of restoring all things to their proper reder in the course of time through a steadily increasing influence on he part of God and of the Light, even though this reconquest from Darkness might take many aeons to achieve, for there could, of ourse, be no question of exerting any force against the free will of he fallen children.

With this provision God thus succeeded in saving His eldest chilten from absolute perdition.

The remaining astral Darkness that surrounded the Globe, and hich had neither fused with the core nor been fixated by the brona of Light, partly absorbed the radiance from the earthly sun's thereal-astral corona of Light, so that the astral counterpart of the arth together with all counterparts of earthly life existing there was it unilluminated, without any appreciable difference between day and night. But the radiance of the sun's less luminous core, which possists of precipitated Darkness enclosed by the Light's slow oscillatons, was able to pass through astral Darkness almost without sistance and to illuminate the earthly world, though it was not able illuminate the astral counterpart of the Globe. (The slowest osciltions that enclose the sun's core will in the course of time become sible to the human eve).

In order to render the primordial state of the Earth's astral counterpart more derstandable to human thought, the following comparison between astral co tions and an earthly scene may serve to illustrate the situation: during a storm example a thunderstorm, which to human beings is a visible manifestation of nowers of Darkness – the dark thunder clouds will, depending on the severity of storm, to a greater or to a lesser extent exclude the rays of the sun that under nor conditions are visible to the human eye. Even though the sunlight has apparently ished, the sun and its rays are still present behind the thick cloud cover. The a Darkness around the entire Earth similarly held back the sun's ethereal-astral rations of Light, so that they reached neither the Earth nor its astral counterpar

According to God's plan, it was the ethereal-astral radiations of the earthly that should have illuminated and irradiated the Earth.

Neither the weakest rays from the sun's core of Darkness, nor most strongly shining rays from the sun's corona of Light, will become visible to the eyes either of human beings or of animal

Since the Eldest had decided to create beings who could me themselves masters of the Earth, they had to try to produce a cuture that, without being an animal, nevertheless had the structuranimals as prototype both in astral and in earthly respects; to so the molecular oscillations of the fixated Darkness and to craftom these alone was impossible from the outset, because of poor capacity for adhesion and cohesion of these molecular Besides, the life-principle of molecular Darkness did not posse sufficiently long-lasting vitality for this to form the sole basis for sufficiently regular and continued reproduction. Thus, it beconecessary for the Eldest to utilize the life-principle of both the as and the molecular Darkness which had been fixated by the coronal Light and which, by fusing with the life-principle that was given God in the corona of Light, had produced cells in all their various.

Being obliged to work with this "double material" to a gextent delayed the Eldest and complicated their aim, and since in pursuit of their goal they constantly "forgot" various minor de that were essential to the whole, it was necessary for them to extend or a long time with the design and assembly of cells into be and organic tissue before they achieved a result that was satisfact to them; a result that in several important and fundamental results.

One of these many imperfections will be described in the foling, since it is of especially great importance to human be namely: the earthly body's insufficient capacity for regeneration

reconstruction of the internal organs, bones, and so forth.

As mentioned earlier, some of the life-seeds that existed in the coona of Light before the wanton destruction by Darkness began were estined by God to appear on Earth, under the influence of the ight, as various animal species having an enduring life in the form ance given, and not being subject to any manner of death or partial destruction. Hence, no law was given by God for the regeneration of host parts or impaired organs, since such a law would have been entirely superfluous in a world of the Light. But when Darkness wakened the latent seeds destined to become animal forms, these ecame in various ways subject to death and decay, and for the igher species of animal there was no prospect of regenerating by ew growth any damaged or lost parts of the body. And when the Ildest created human beings, partly with the existing animal forms s prototypes for their internal structure, they forgot, confused as hey were by Darkness, to take this deficiency into account. For this ason the Eldest established no laws for a more extensive recontruction of the human body.

Thus: in cases where human beings through accident or through ecessary amputation lose an entire limb or part of a limb, the loss annot be made good by any form of regenerative growth. Nor can inyone, no matter how highly developed the spirit, by the power of ill or by the radiations of the spirit-body, cause new parts or new in the damaged areas. Neither will prayers to God nor alls upon His assistance be of the least benefit in such cases; since and never violates the law for the construction and existence of the luman body, the imperfect law that was established and followed by the Eldest when they formed and created the first human beings, and the loss deficiency they alone bear the full responsibility.

The possibility that God would take upon himself any responsibily for so incomplete a creation as the human body, which in every spect is a very poor imitation of God's own creation, is absolutely ut of the question.

Even if it had been God's intention by the power of His Will to approve upon the creatures of the Eldest by establishing laws for the generation of excised organs and amputated limbs, this would not we been the only change necessary, since the human body as it now pears from the hand of its creators is singularly imperfect in veral other respects of importance to human beings.

However, if God had sought to relieve these deficiencies and to tablish laws for the perfection and reconstruction of the physical dv. He would thereby also have accepted responsibility for His lien children's work of creation. But God would no more do this

than an artist on Earth would accept responsibility for the botch and bungling of a pupil or an imitator. God will therefore no change that which was once given by the Eldest. But He trithrough the intelligence with which He has enriched human being to mitigate some of the many deficiencies. (For example, through the intelligence with which He has enriched human being the many deficiencies.)

Through the many incarnations, the human spirit builds up individual personality. Just as a mature or aging person can member and look back upon thoughts and feelings and recall in dents and actions from early childhood, and yet as an adult in every way be able to identify with the child maturing slowly over the deand years, so can the released spirit remember as far back in time thought can reach and still feel a complete identity with all the man beings to whom it has given spiritual life. The gradual development of the self unfolds before the spirit as kaleidoscopic image from the first feeble and weak personal beings to whom it has be bound to those who through a slow progression have become me highly developed and more conscious personalities.

Therefore: just as a human being at any given time represents sum of his or her life, so does the individual personality of a relespirit represent the sum of the thoughts, feelings, actions and expenses of all its previous lives on Earth.

However, the incarnations of the Youngest² present a differ picture. When the Youngest promised God to become the lead and mentors of human beings they were already highly developersonalities. When they look back on the lives that they have lead human beings, they feel – to use an easily understandable illustrater from earthly life – more like actors and actresses who recall the stigures to whom they have given life over the years by their artitalent. Actors always prefer the stage roles that most closely expetheir true selves and were brought to life in the portrayal because the actors' distinctive character. In the same way will also the You est in their recollection of previous lives feel most attracted to will most closely identify with those human beings on whom have left the purest and most noble imprint of their spirit's example.

ndividuality. And like the actors who on leaving the stage will cast iff their masks and reveal their true selves, so will also the Youngest, when at death they leave the earthly scene and once more awaken to all consciousness, cast off the human mask and appear as the highly eveloped individualities that they were before entering the earthly large to take part in the great drama of the world.

The Eldest, who through their wilful embodiment as human beings brought themselves under the Law of Retribution, must – hearnation after incarnation – all restore their personalities, which ere debased and distorted by Darkness. But in His deep compasion God extends the greatest possible help to these unfortunate eings by blotting out, as far as this is possible, the memory of all hat they had experienced before the Earth came into being, so that all appearances they are like human spirits.

Just as every released human spirit can look back upon its struggle but of Darkness and forward toward the Light, so can God follow is own struggle out of Darkness through past eternity until the nal victory was reached. But to God it is not retrospection but exerience in the present; for as He carries all time – finite as well as inhite – in His all-embracing Thought, the concept of time does not ist for Him.

The concepts of time and space are given by God for the use of all created fings; thus all of them are to a greater or lesser degree dependent on these incepts. The higher the spirit rises, the more it will be freed from these limiting incepts, but it will never gain full mastery over time and space. Since they were manated by God through the power of His Will, even God's Servants cannot attain implete release from the concepts of time and space. Where God wishes to be, ere He is, the same instant that the Thought arises; but for God's Servants some must pass from the conception of the thought until it is carried out. It takes, example, three seconds for God's Servants to cover the distance between God's ingdom and the Earth.

In all that has been created or called to life on Earth there is a faint flection of God's own struggle forward. Each planted seed lies a closed in the darkness of the Earth until it inevitably sprouts forth ward the light. The human child and the mammal's young lie closed in the darkness of the maternal womb until the moment of the seed in the darkness of the egg until also they evitably struggle forth from the shell, and so forth. But the struges of the seed, the child, the mammal's young and the young of the seed, the child, from becoming into being, these are

unconscious, for it is the victorious power of the Light that dra them forth. These *unconscious* struggles are thus no more than voluntary imitations of God's *conscious* struggle.

Also in the struggle of mankind away from primitive, beast-libeings – caricatures of their creators – to the state of developm now attained by the average human being can be seen a faint flection and a likeness of God's own struggle but of Darkness.

The greatest likeness can be found, however, in the strug forward of each individual human spirit through the many eart incarnations from the deepest spiritual Darkness until certainty the spirit's own sovereign will for the Light releases it from Earth and leads it slowly to the goal - God's Kingdom - a goal t still lies far into the future for even the most advanced human spi

The unceasing struggle of earthly life away from Darkness toward the Light is first of all due to the Earth's ethereal coron Light, which by its fixation of the Darkness that was separated at the fall of the Eldest became able to influence the earthly-mate products of Darkness, and which by the strength that God concentrated in its radiations became able to bring the chaotic and distorted life-forms of Darkness into a more orderly state. on Earth as human beings experience it therefore became a ceast struggle from the possibility to the reality of life, an existence on account of the short life span allotted to the material product Darkness is constantly subject to decline, withering, death destruction; a struggle and a cycle that will continue as long as condutons for life on Earth obtain.

Even though the sun's role as the Earth's physical source of and light must not be disregarded, but must always be taken consideration in connection with life on Earth, the solar rays of never have called forth the profusion of forms of life that exist the Earth, had the ethereal corona of Light – the Earth's son psyche – not existed. Nor would the radiance of the sun have able to exercise any significant regulating influence on existing ditions, apart from the greater or lesser influence that is dependent on and arises from the various positions of the Globe in relation the sun, and from the distance of the various regions of the I from its equator.

But since God, by the power of His Will, has formed an et corona of Light around the Earth, its radiations of energy su and strengthen the radiance of the sun that penetrates the apheric layers to benefit the Globe, so that the influence or radiance upon earthly life thereby acquires a greater and more able significance.

Since the sun has to a great extent been affected by the many collisions with commulations of Darkness that drifted, and which still drift, about in space, those diations that reach the Earth through the atmospheric layers are not of a uniform trength, because the rays from the affected parts are considerably weaker than the thers. These differences influence the meteorological and climatic conditions.

The Ice Ages of the Earth were caused by the reduced strength of the sun's idiance after collisions with drifting accumulations of Darkness; but since the radice from the sun's corona of Light and the surrounding Light-ether have elimited large portions of the accumulations of Darkness that were depolarized by the ollision, more normal climatic conditions prevail once more on Earth at this time, any thousands of years later.

The corona of Light also acts as a condensing medium for the adiance of the sun that reaches the Earth. If the corona did not kist, the solar rays would be refracted during their passage through Le Earth's atmospheric layers, and would seem to earthly eyes to be oken and scattered. Since the corona not only now encloses the hole Globe, but has in addition fixated the Darkness to whose astral and molecular oscillations the earthly bodies and the earthly forms we their existence, all luminous bodies and sources of light each parately appear, like sunlight, with a unified monochrome radiaon of light. As the corona is cleansed of Darkness, which takes ace exceedingly slowly, it will become better and better able to vercome the capacity for refraction and colour-separation of the mosphere, of water, glass and other materials. This slowly incasing resistance of the corona to all² forms of refraction and scating will at some time in the future be of advantage to instruments astronomic observations, when lenses will admit of significant largement without the colour tones of refraction interfering with astronomic observations.

The Earth's ethereal corona of Light is the vital energy of earthly a stabilizing, sustaining, regulating, unifying, stimulating and newing energy that constantly radiates power and strength to the allest things as well as to the largest; an energy that can never be stroyed by Darkness, and which never diminishes, regardless of much energy it radiates.

hus: life on Earth is primarily dependent on the ethereal corona

The colours will gradually etherealize, i.e., they will become purer and clearer until they disappear completely.

The special refraction that causes the colour-spectrum at sunrise and sunset will become more difficult for the corona of Light to overcome than ordinary refraction. The time dequired will probably exceed the millions of years that in all probability are still allotearthly life. However, during the Earth's lifetime, mankind will be able to observe the ealization of the colour-spectrum produced by this special refraction.
