evolvement in physical life experience, their sensitivity to divine aid and their extensive help from both worlds enabled them to grow in wisdom and in love.

"The reputation which mythology has bestowed upon Cassandra of Troy is basically false. It is true that she was the most beautiful of King Priam's daughters. She was the most beautiful woman of Troy. Her extraordinary beauty in itself was responsible for many of the false tales which jealous women and frustrated suitors spread against her. In her case, her beauty had been earned by many lifetimes of dedication and achievement. It was wasted on Trov.
