for granted by the recipient and therefore there is no real help given. What we are coming round to is that charity that is not received with appreciation by the recipient is actually of no value to him, therefore he would be better off without it. But this is not an excuse for the selfish to withhold charity because his heart is not filled with charity in the beginning. You must help one another. But you must study the situation in question and be sure that the gift is of true value in order that the greatest good may accrue to both the giver and the receiver.

To do for others anything that they can and should do for themselves, is a detriment, not a benefit. To refuse to do for others what we can do and which they need and cannot do for themselves is against the law of the Golden Rule and is wrong. This is the basic point you must look for in your giving. Does this person need this help or is he simply demanding it because he is too indolent to do for himself? If the latter is the case, he will resent you for giving it. If he truly needs it, he will be deeply appreciative and resentment will not appear in the relationship between you at all. If there is resentment in the relationship as the result of help given, it is time to look deeper and reassess the nature of the charity.

Of all the people you have known who are handicapped by inadequacy, very few are truly physically handicapped. By that, we mean lacking in having a complete physical body. Many of them are handicapped by symptoms of physical illness that appear to rescue them from the ordeal of undertaking something that is greater than they want to undertake. These

symptoms are real, very real. They are seldom understood by the individuals. They only know that when the going gets rough the symptoms of illness do appear and they become ill. Sometimes very ill, so that they are released from the need to rise to the occasion and surmount the problem before them. This alone is the key to the lack of progress in many, many souls. They come into life with the intention of doing the things they need to do in order to progress in their spiritual development. They go unerringly into the situations that will give them this development, but when the situation confronts them they fold up with an attack of illness that makes it necessary for someone else to take over the responsibility and relieve them of it.

The result—the benefit accrues to the benefactor instead of the beneficiary, who is the one who got himself into the situation in the first place so that he could have the benefit of the experience for his own development. He is cheated out of it by circumstances beyond his control, so he thinks, and this explains why he is so often resentful of the person who has given him help when it would seem he should be deeply a preciative of the help given. Actually, what he has lost is so much greater than what he has gained that he has been cheated and his spirit will never allow him to show complete appreciation to his benefactor in this type of circumstance.

Whenever you come to grips with this sort of circumstance, work out a solution for the soul who is requiring your help that will give him the minimum of help, not the most, for the objective they are spiritually attempting to achieve is to "do it himself." Remember

that he will invariably resent the soul who steps in and does it for him, for that soul cheats him out of the accomplishment and then gains the benefit of that accomplishment for himself. Then the cheated soul must turn to other channels for his accomplishment and in so doing he very often treats his benefactor shabbily, if not dishonestly. This sets up a karmic situation that his spirit recognizes and the benefactor becomes the object of resentment, not of appreciation.

This is what happens when you step in to give help where it is asked for but not actually needed as much as it might appear. It is something that must be particularly guarded against by parents. It is so natural for children in a tight spot to yell for "Mama," and so natural for mothers or fathers to fly to the rescue when they hear the call. But before you go too far, weigh the situation in this light and work out the help you give carefully so that the child may be left with his opportunity to go on to his attainment of his own life's objectives. This will relieve a parent's feeling of resentment in reaction to the resentment of the child. This is something that parents the world round have found so hard to understand from the beginning of time on the earth scene.

There is a matter of help that is asked that is not of a material nature. It is the request for advice in the case of trouble. Everyone has trouble. This is a part of earth life. It is the part of earth life that carries the greatest challenge and also the most difficulty. Everyone faces trouble. It is a definite part of the plan in earth life and cannot be avoided. What we do about it is the question.

The secret of success in life is not necessarily the avoiding of trouble, although to avoid creating more trouble than we need have is very important indeed. But how to cope with the troubles we cannot avoid is the need of every soul. This requires that we acquire wisdom This we gain from instruction, from study, and from experience. If we acquire sufficient wisdom to deal with the troubles in our own lives, we will find others will come to us seeking help in dealing with their troubles.

No one ever asks for help on a problem to which he already has the solution. He comes because he has trouble and no solution. In order to help constructively we must have wisdom on which to draw. If we do not have the answer ourselves, we need to be able to direct him to the authority who does have it. This is basic wisdom in itself. Go to the teachings of Jesus for the basic principles of universal law that are the ruling forces in our lives. Be sure that the advice you give embraces these principles at all times or the advice is not good and is of no value. Beyond that, try to be specific in imparting any knowledge you may possess to give direction and help to another in solving his problem.

Do not take another's problems and solve them for him unless you are certain that he is unable to cope with them himself. To do that robs him of the experience and creates a karmic imbalance. There are many instances in which you do need to give help, physical help in situations where he cannot handle it himself. But at all times remember the rule: Do not do for another anything he can and should do for himself.
